PLAN FOR REOPENING OF FACE TO FACE BRIDGE AT THE LION CENTRE, WK

At a recent Bridge Club Executive Meeting the following was agreed and proposed as a plan for restarting 'Face to Face' bridge at the Lion's Centre

1. All 3 games (Tuesday afternoon, Thursday morning and Thursday afternoon games) to restart, subject to all games having access to the large room. If the large room is not available for the Thursday morning game then this game would not restart. Further if this Thursday morning is allowed, the club would like the City of West Kelowna to advertise this game as a beginner 'Drop In' game. If this game does not restart then no advertising is required
2. A bridge play session is limited to 10 tables initially. This represents 40 players + 1 game director - total 41 people. If after a period of time there appears to be sufficient demand, a play session would be increased to 12 tables ie 48 + 1 = 49 people. To ensure social distancing is maintained, the extra 2 tables would make use of the stage area (see layout plan at the end)
3. To ensure a maximum of 40 people show up, players will have to pre sign up on the club's website. Club members only are allowed to sign up for the Tuesday and Thursday afternoon (open) games. For the Thursday morning game (assuming it goes ahead) it would be open to both members and non members (drop in). Non members will have to sign up to play via the website (just like members)
4. An individual who signs up on the website to play bridge for a specific game play session must also complete a Covid-19 screening questionnaire (see at the end of this document)
5. No food or drink to be offered during game play - individuals can bring their own refreshments which are not to be shared. The kitchen to remain closed and locked
6. To ensure that 2 meter self distancing is achieved while play takes place, the following table layout (located at the end of this document) is to be strictly adhered to. To this end, the club would like to use the long wooden fold up tables (10 tables)
7. Once the tables are set up, they would be sanitized with wipes and each table would have a container of hand sanitizer on it, to be used prior to touching any equipment and available at all times during game play
8. Sanitizing wipes would be available to all players at the entrance to the hall. Each player on entering the facility takes a wipe(s) for sanitization purposes
9. With their wipe, an individual collects their own chair and bridge playing equipment wipes them down before placing them at a table.

10. All equipment used by the Game Director is to be handled by the Game Director only.
The equipment is to be sanitized and wiped over before and after use
11. Common sense to be used when accessing the bathroom - use available wipes and hand sanitizer
12. Face coverings are required to be worn by all players at all times
13. On completion of a game, players are to re-stack their chairs and leave the building without waiting around to discuss the game or review the final results
14. One person will be designated at each session to oversee that all safe practices are being followed

BRIDGE BOARDS

In order to play bridge, the club uses playing cards that are pre sorted by a machine. This is called board set up and is performed by one individual who comes to the Lions Centre on a non game play date to prepare the boards, Board preparation is done in the bridge equipment storage room. Equipment and boards to be sanitized and wiped before and after preparing the boards

REQUESTED ACTIONS FROM THE LIONS CENTRE

Room is cleaned and sanitized prior to a club member entering the facility in time for the agreed times of operation

If possible, the large wooden tables (10 tables) are to be set up by Lions Centre staff prior a club session. If this is not possible, that the tables are not stacked under the stage where they are awkward to get at

One entrance only to the facility (preference is the ramp access for wheelchair use)

If required, Lions Centre staff to periodically check that all agreed safety practices are being followed

If possible items that are often hard to come by - hand sanitizer, sanitizing wipes and face masks to be purchased by the City of West Kelowna and billed to the club

IF APPROVED, WE PROPOSE BRIDGE WOULD RESTART ON TUESDAY AUGUST 4TH
